Mother of Pearl is a lustrous and shiny iridescent pattern that mimics the organic inner layer of oyster shells. The layout features a clean, stripped pattern.

The subtle texture **Western Leather** is soft and tactile. The paper creates a vivid speckled effect.

Bengal has exotic, "wild-looking" markings like a tiger pattern. The embossed pattern adds great interest and dimension.

Imprinted with a small lizard-skin pattern, **Chameleon** has a delightful exotic look.

Faux Tortoise is a beautiful, multi-colored wallcovering that has complex tones fading softly from one to another in random directional patterns. The versatility of tortoise shell makes it perfect for accessorizing in any space as it is both classic and stylish.

The wood grains of **Eastwood** are tremendously touchable and realistic. There are 5 new enchanting colorways of this bona fide faux bois pattern in addition to the 4 original colorways introduced in Texture Resource Vol. 4.

Luberon has a heavy, industrial look and feel. This thick vinyl has a subtle striae printed on top along the embossed ribbed pattern.

Belgium Linen is a sophisticated linen-like embossed vinyl that combines a fine woven pattern with warm texture.

Andes has an all-over large zig-zag block motif on a linen-like ground. Colorways include navy and tone on tone neutrals, and a popping metallic silver and charcoal.

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An imitation of the natural material in an embossed vinyl form, the slubbed **Arrowroot** texture is highlighted by the natural-looking color variance.

Tobago Weave gives the allure of fine basket weaving. The rhythmic weave of the large and small fibers gives a rough and rugged appeal.

Dublin Weave looks like burlap and encompasses the feel of tightly woven canvas.

Bankun Raffia features a tight faux-weave with tie marks, like real woven palm leaves. This popular wallpaper comes in 30 colorways that add depth and dimension that cannot be achieved with paint.
